- d. Nils I think I have a coupon for tshirt elephant so I'll let you know, and they have sales pretty often so look out for that.
- e. Michael If APSA is sponsoring, will we continue to sponsor this or will it come out of your surplus if you end up getting more interest and needing more money?
- f. Fred It will depend on how much interest we get but right now I'm only asking \$200.
- g. Scott They are very involved and have a lot of activity and I think we should be promoting this.
- h. Jadin Will these people be APSA members?
- i. Fred Yes that will be a part of it.
- j. Ayush Will this start all clubs asking for money, is that sustainable for APSA?
- k. Scott I think we want to promote what we can until it's not in the budget anymore.
- I. Sam Will it be continual orders? And then continual APSA subsidies?
- m. Fred This is a pilot to see total interest, and we will see how it goes to get a good gauge of how much money we would need so if we need more I'd let you know first before spending this \$200.
- n. Colleen If it's \$20 without the subsidy, I don't think that's unreasonable to ask people to pay.
- o. Fred Yes, but APSA's help would let us do a surplus to fund future events.
