Role: Program Manager, Student

Location: Whitehorse, Yukon

Academic Year: 3rd or 4th year (needs to have an understanding of services to be able to collaborate with the government)

Start/End: flexible and open to discussion. 4-8 week commitment preferred, or until your next term starts in September.

Compensation: \$40-50/hr depending on program management experience and year. **ALL EXPENSES PAID** including flights and accommodations. Vehicle available for use/car rental paid.

Hours: As this is largely a program management/office role in phase 1 (see below), hours and days worked can be negotiated, ie. If you'd like to do 4 days and have 3 days off to explore the beautiful wilderness of the Yukon, I am open to discussing.

Job Description: You will be responsible for building the clinical practice program over 2 phases from scratch:

-Phase 1: Review of net new clinical services available in Yukon, market research and analysis, consumer and patient care research, SOPs including operational best practices and creation of documents for all identified clinical service offerings, and presentation creation. Program development will require successful candidate to collaborate with subject matter experts and relevant stakeholders in central office to ensure coordination of effort and alignment with Shoppers Drug Mart Health and Wellness Strategy. This includes, but not limited to, pharmacy innovation, professional affairs, operations, and professional services teams. You may be presenting and working with Senior Managers and Directors or up, which means you'll get tons of experience in how we develop strategy and then operationalize it to our community.

-Phase 2: pilot and initiate continuous improvement with in-store implementation and collection of data to support presentations to potentially internal and external partners such as the Government of Yukon. Generating, developing, and laying the groundwork for a longitudinal clinical business for future students and pharmacists.
