- Met with a Diabetes Canada representative to discuss their organization's current goals and initiatives (Diabetes 360 strategy, D-Camps day camps for children)
- Began groundwork for a food bank volunteer opportunity for students in the Edmonton area (presented by a student from the Class of 2023)
  - Obtained demographic information from Faculty about where students are located to see whether it would be worthwhile to expand this initiative beyond Edmonton
  - Contacted Calgary Food Bank to find out about potential volunteer opportunities this is unlikely to be feasible for students at this time as they currently require an ongoing weekly commitment
- Participated in CAPSI National Advocacy Committee meeting and discussions
  - Discussions this year are focused around developing a unified scope of practice for pharmacists across Canada
- Attended PAM Committee meeting and discussions
- Held meetings and discussions with the SAF-Pharm Committee about direction for this year
  - Advocacy (conversation about what impact pharmacy students can have)
  - Trade Show (discussions about webinar format, vendors, participation incentives)
  - Health promotion activities (e.g. developing patient resources)
- Had meetings with a GSK Pharmaceuticals representative and organized two Lunch & Learns for the Winter 2021 semester
