- Formed the Race Against Racism committee, promoting RaR committee
- Attended APSA Orientation and gave a short presentation about CAPSI
- Wrote CAPSI Article to be in PQ+2 (September Edition)
- Along with the Race Against Racism committee, made weekly instagram posts addressing racism and inequalities in the healthcare system
